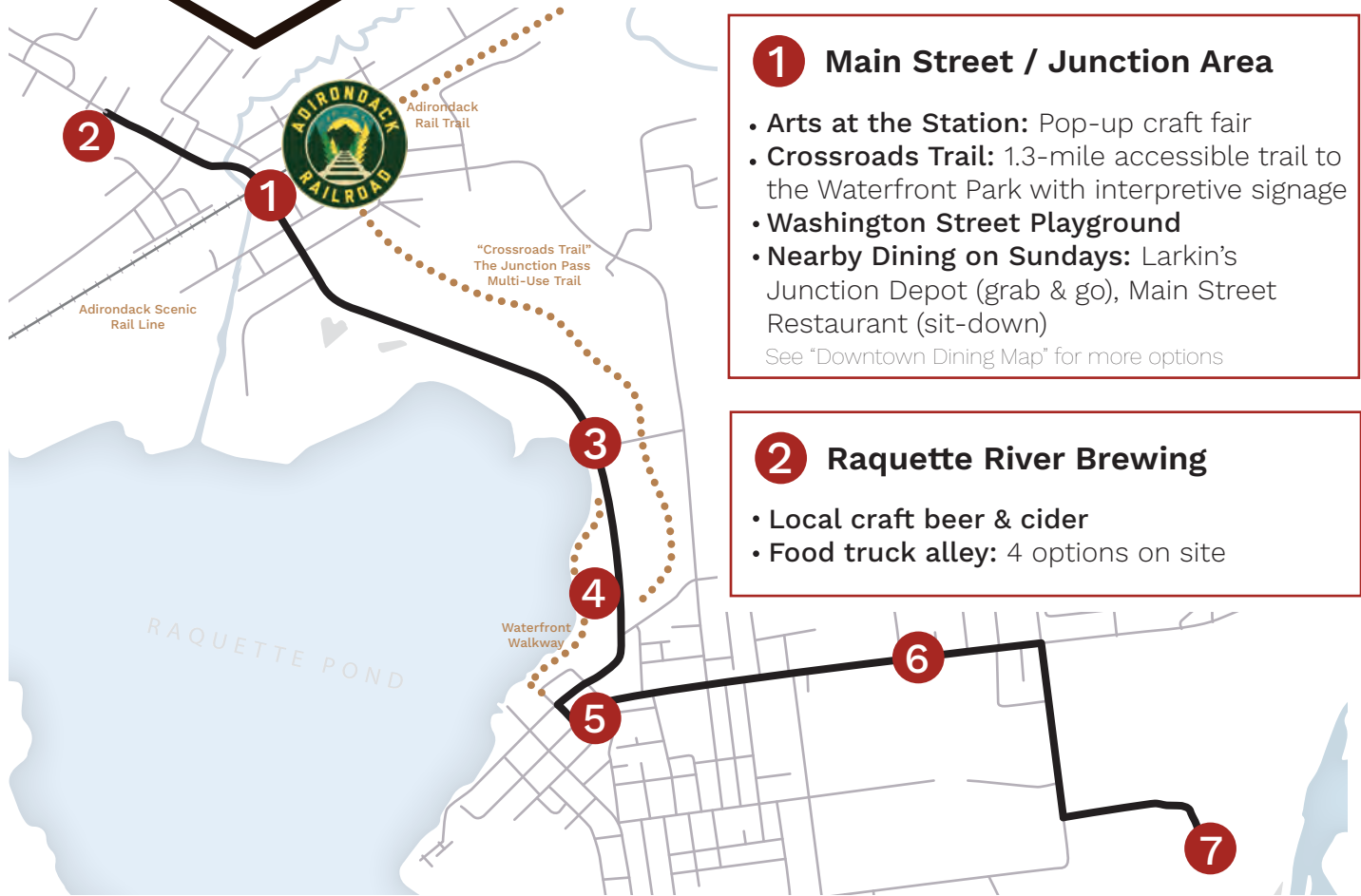




# Welcome!

## Sunday Shuttle Map For Train Passengers



### 1 Main Street / Junction Area

- **Arts at the Station:** Pop-up craft fair
- **Crossroads Trail:** 1.3-mile accessible trail to the Waterfront Park with interpretive signage
- **Washington Street Playground**
- **Nearby Dining on Sundays:** Larkin's Junction Depot (grab & go), Main Street Restaurant (sit-down)

### 2 Raquette River Brewing

### 3 Timberjaxx Pass

Opens at 1 p.m.  
on Sundays

### 4 Tupper Lake Waterfront Park

- **Scenic walkway & overlooks**
- **Picnic areas**
- **Little Loggers Playground**
- **Short walk** to Park Street Business District and Timberjaxx Pass (or follow the Crossroads Trail back to the Train Station 1.3 miles)

### 5 Park Street Business District

- **Shops:** Adirondack Store & Gallery, Spruce & Hemlock, Juicy Jay's, Shenandoah Arts & Crafts, Tupper Ars, McClland Family Farmstand
- **Dining:** Amado, Swiss Kitchen, Guido's Pizzeria, Washboard Donut Shop
- **Attractions:** Tupper Arts and The Adirondack State Theater (1 p.m. matinee)
