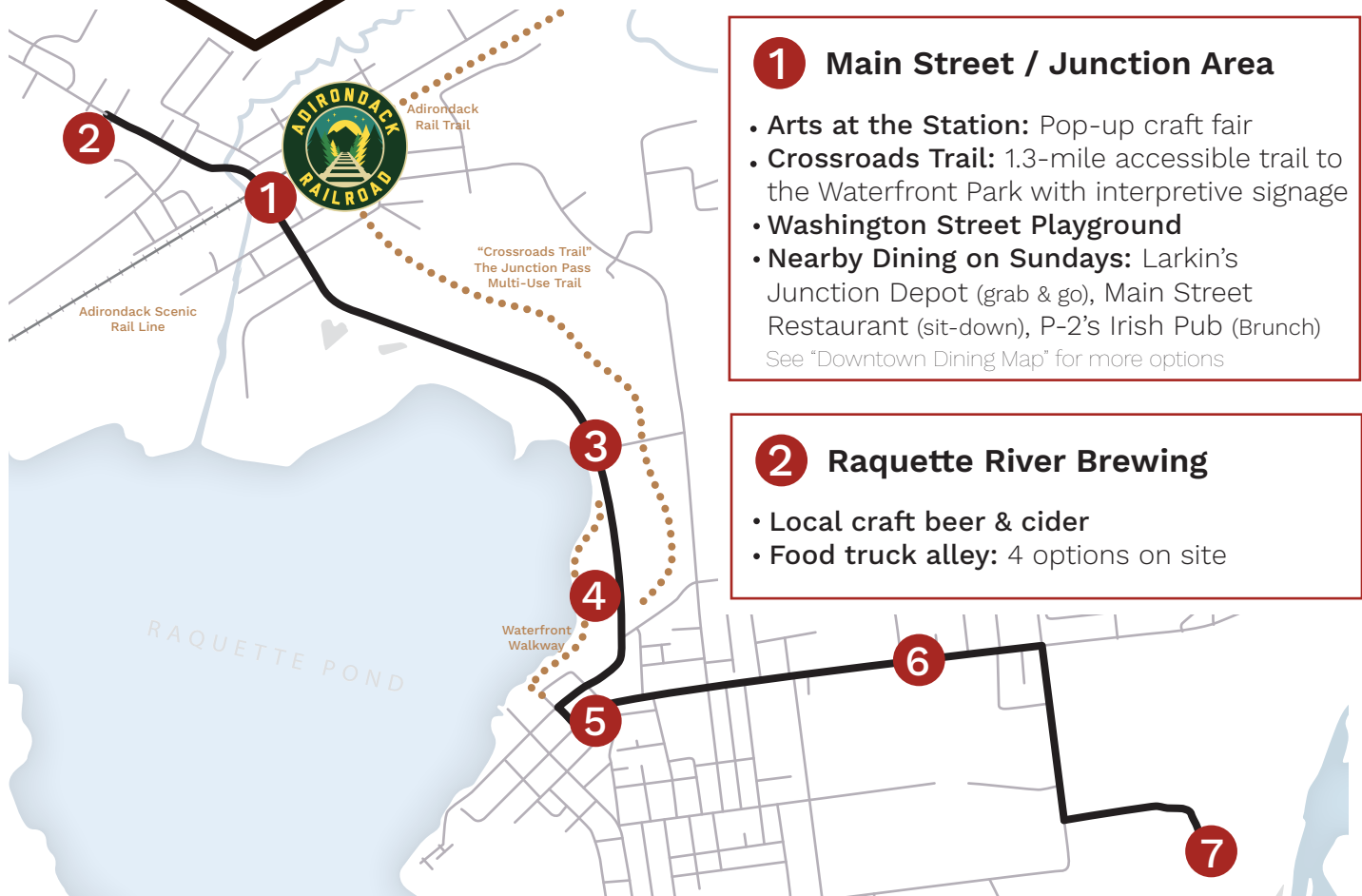

1 Main Street / Junction Area

- **Crossroads Trail:** 1.3-mile accessible trail to the Waterfront Park with interpretive signage

- **Shops:** Adirondack Store & Gallery, Spruce & Hemlock, Juicy Jay's, Shenandoah Arts & Crafts, Tupper Ars
- **Dining:** Amado, Guido's Pizzeria, Jet ADK Nutrition, Little Italy, MSO Swiss Kitchen, Spruce & Hemlock, Washboard Donut Shop
- **Attractions:** Tupper Arts and The Adirondack State Theater (1 p.m. matinee)
